Relay baton measuring gauge

The Mum- Sport relay baton measuring gauge enables the checking of the relay baton. You are able to check if a relay baton is legal according to the IWR rule 170.12. It is an immediate and easy decision.

It is done as follows:

Check the composition of the relay baton (material, form, surface). Then check the relay baton's weight. Use a standardized and calibrated scale (calibration class III). The legal weight of a relay baton amounts at least 50 grams (IWR rule 170.12).

To check the legal outer diameter (\varnothing) of the relay baton, use the Mum- Sport relay baton measuring gauge. The minimum/ maximum diameter is checked easily.

To check the legal length, place the relay baton on the measuring gauge. The relay baton's length has to be within the green markings (on the measuring gauge).



If the relay baton is within the green area, the relay baton is legal.

Diameter checking: The relay baton has to fit through the maximum hole.

The relay baton must not fit through the minimum hole.
